

Interactive Mental Health Simulation session – Maudsley Simulation

are running a 2hr taster session from 15.00 to 17.00 on Thursday 14.6 and again on Friday 15.6 to demonstrate mental health simulation as an educational tool for healthcare professionals attending the NCP. The session takes place in the University Hospital Simulation Centre at Ármúli 1 in Reykjavik. Coach transfer will be provided from main entrance of the Harpa Convention Centre to Ármúli 1 leaving at 14.40 each day and returning at 17.20 to the Harpa again. After a brief introduction, the session runs simulated scenarios involving a simulated suicidal patient with depressive symptoms and unhelpful coping mechanisms, before demonstrating models of group debriefing. This interactive sessions gives professionals interested in simulation an educational tool to improve clinical care and the chance to experience and learn from this engaging modality.
